



# BBQ Boat

## Hire Terms and Procedures

- A \$250 deposit is required to confirm your BBQ boat booking with the balance due on boarding.
- 14 days notice is required for a cancellation refund.
- We are unable to cancel or postpone bookings due to wet weather. In the case of extreme weather events, management will decide if the actual weather/predictions on the day of hire are deemed unsafe, then the option to either transfer to another date or receive a refund will apply.
- All other reasons for cancellation will incur loss of deposit unless the hire can be re-booked on the day.
- A \$250 security bond is required on the day. This can be paid by pre-authorisation on a credit card, cash or EFT.
- Hirer/Driver must be 18 yrs or over to Hire/Drive the boats
- All instructions, [NSW Waterways Regulations](#), navigation channel markers and area limits must be obeyed and will be shown before leaving the marina.
- An induction will occur on the safe operation of the hired vessel including the use of the anchor and motor.
- Mobile phones must be turned on to enable emergency contact.
- The hirer is responsible for any damages to BBQ boat or other vessels or loss of property whilst on hire.
- Access to the roof is prohibited
- No towing.
- Bow riding is illegal - bow riding means extending any part of your body outside the perimeter of a vessel that is underway.
- Designated driver (skipper) must remain under the legal blood alcohol limit of less than 0.05. Random breath testing may occur on the river at any time.
- Children under 12 must wear a life jacket, these can be provided on request.
- If the hirer is alone or has children under 12 then they must also wear a life jacket at all times.
- There is no refund for early return of the boat.
- Late returns or call outs will incur a \$100/hour fee.
- Please do not use the table as a cutting board - a bait board is provided.
- Driving this boat onto any rocky areas or ramps will result in loss of security bond.
- **Do not flush sanitary items, wet wipes or foreign objects down the toilet.** A \$250 unblocking fee applies if the toilet is blocked.
- **Please keep the waterways clean** - you must use the bins provided. Do not throw rubbish or cigarette butts overboard. A bin is provided for recycling (glass, plastic bottles and cans) and another for general rubbish.
- The BBQ boats are licenced for hire in the daylight hours only - 8am till 4pm (NSW time).
- The BBQ boats are licenced for a maximum number of passengers, if limit is exceeded, a loss of security bond will occur.
- Hiring of this boat is undertaken at your own risk and no responsibility for Injury is accepted by management.
